

# 2026-TROOP/ PARENT INFORMATION SHEET:

**SCOUTMASTER'S PLEASE BE SURE THAT YOUR SCOUT'S ARE PREPARED. IF THE SCOUTS DO NOT HAVE THE PROPER PAPERWORK LISTED BELOW, THEY WILL BE TURNED AWAY.**

1. It will be the duty of the Troop to be sure that each Scout is prepared. Any Scout that is not prepared maybe asked to leave the session. Please review with Scout and parent.
2. All pre-requirements must be provided to the MBC prior to the start of the merit badge session. \*NOTE: Scouts will be turned away from the session if this is NOT provided.
3. All Scouts must turn in a completed/ signed blue card to the MBC, prior to the start of the session.
4. Each Scout must have the Merit Badge pamphlet and printed 'PDF' of the Merit badge Workbook.
5. Each Scout must print out and fill out the 'PDF' Merit Badge Workbook.
6. \*Requirements that have 30-60-90-day time frames will receive partials unless the requirement is approved by the parent or Scout Leader claiming that the work has been completed. Please sign off in the 'Worksheet'.
7. Scouts must be prepared to discuss all requirements. Have parents/ Scoutmaster/ Troop Advancement Chair sign/approve on printed 'Worksheet' any/ all requirements that involve visits or 'to do' requirements.
8. Each Scout must be wearing a Class 'A' shirt.
9. All Scouts, registered Scout Leaders, Staff and MBC's NO COVID paperwork is required this year. The required paperwork is a signed medical forms part: A, B1 and B2 (which doesn't require a physician's signature). Bring copies.
10. All Scouts can bring a bagged lunch. **However, a free will be lunch will be provided this year compliments of the OA.**
11. All Scouts must bring paper and pencil/ pen for writing and taking notes. This will not be provided.
12. Each Scout and adult will be required to bring their own camp chair. Picnic tables are for the counselors use ONLY.
13. It will be the duty of the Unit LEADERS to be sure that each Scout is prepared. Any Scout that is not prepared maybe asked to leave the session.
14. All sessions are 3 hours long. One session is all day and another session is 1-1/2 hours.
15. Scouts must be registered for their Merit Badge sessions.
16. **NEW** this year an all-day ILST session will be available, maximum size 10 scouts.

## **NOTE:**

1. MBC's will have to be registered MBC's, have updated YPT and CBC forms on file.
2. Each Merit Badge sessions will have a maximum of 15 Scouts.
3. An adult leader from each Unit will be required to be in attendance all day.
4. If we must cancel this event, we will reschedule it in the fall of 2024 or replace it with a virtual date. If a session is dropped the day of the event, we will try and get your scout into another session (this is totally out of our control).
