

DRUGS, ALCOHOL, & TOBACCO

The Michigan Crossroads Council and Scouting America are committed to providing a safe, healthy, and productive camp experience.

The possession, use, distribution, or being under the influence of illegal drugs, including marijuana as defined under federal, state, or local law, and/or the possession of drug paraphernalia is strictly prohibited on any property (including camps) owned or operated by the Michigan Crossroads Council or Scouting America.

The use, possession, or distribution of any cannabidiol (CBD) products, including, but not limited to, oils, gummies, edibles/drinks, vapes, or capsules, is also prohibited, regardless of their legal status outside of camp. Similarly, any non-marijuana products containing tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), such as concentrates, vape cartridges, capsules, or edibles/drinks, are not permitted. These substances pose safety risks, are incompatible with a youth camp environment, and any possession or use will be considered a violation of this policy.

Smoking is permitted **only** in designated smoking areas, away from campers and guests. Cigarettes, cigars, pipes, e-cigarettes, vapes, snuff, chew, and other tobacco or nicotine delivery products are not permitted outside of these areas.

The possession, consumption, or influence of alcohol, including beer, is strictly prohibited on all Michigan Crossroads Council and Scouting America properties.

Violation of this policy will result in immediate removal from camp, without refund, and may result in legal prosecution.

Proper use of prescription medication by a patient under the care of a physician is permitted; however, all prescription medications must be dispensed by the Camp Health Director or the designated Unit Leader in accordance with Scouting America rules.

Michigan Crossroads Council Camps are “**Drug- and Alcohol-Free Zones.**”

For the purposes of this policy, marijuana is considered an illegal drug and not a prescribed medication.
