## Shelter and bedding

- ☐ Tent with rain fly, poles, stakes
- ☐ Tarp
- ☐ Rope
- ☐ Sleeping pad, mats, air mattress, air pump
- ☐ Blanket, comforter, or sleeping bag
- ☐ Pillows
- ☐ Camp Chair

## Cooking and dining

(Most should be provided by the troop)

- ☐ Pots and pans
- ☐ Cutting board
- ☐ Can opener
- ☐ Mixing bowls
- ☐ Empty food containers
- ☐ Aluminum foil
- ☐ Zip lock bags
- ☐ Cooler
- ☐ Folding chairs and table
- ☐ Trash bags
- ☐ Camp stove / smoker / Dutch oven
- ☐ Fuel and Charcoal
- ☐ Lighter
- ☐ Knives and cooking utensils
- ☐ Plates, Bowls, and utensils or mess kit
- ☐ Dish Washing Station
- ☐ Dish Washing rags or scrubbers

## Clothing and laundry

- ☐ T-shirts
- ☐ Pants
- ☐ Warm and Dry Boots and Tennis Shoes.
- ☐ 3-4 Pairs of Socks
- ☐ Hat, cap
- ☐ Sweater and rain jacket
- ☐ Neck gaiter/buff, scarf

- ☐ Underwear
- ☐ Towels, washcloths
- ☐ Laundry bag
- ☐ Work Gloves
- ☐ Warm Clothes that can get dirty.
- ☐ Class B Scout Shirt
- ☐ Scout Uniform

## First aid & hygiene

- ☐ Medication, prescriptions
- ☐ First Aid Kit
- ☐ Wet Wipes
- ☐ Deodorant
- ☐ Tooth Brush and Tooth Paste
- ☐ Hand Sanitizer
- ☐ Liquid Soap
- ☐ Bug Spray
- ☐ Body and Foot Powder
- ☐ Braces, Contacts, or Glasses Case
- ☐ Toilet paper (be prepared)

- ☐ Backpack for Scout Stuff

- ☐ Pocket Knife (with totin chip)

- ☐ Duty Rosters, Menus, Recipes and other troop materials for your position.
