Directions at Phillippo

Park in the main lot, then send your Scoutmaster and SPL to the campmaster cabin (Nicollet) to check in with our administration staff.

ARROW OF LIGHT CUBS

These fifth-grade cubs may attend for either overnight or day programs, as long as within the above defined temperature range.

Per the most recent changes to the Guide to Safe Scouting, fourth-grade Webelos cubs may not attend camporee for the day or weekend.

- Long Underwear
- Wicking shirt (long-sleeve preferred)
- Thin inner socks*
- Thin inner gloves

Warmth Layer

- Warm pants*
- Warm sweatshirt*
- Socks*
- Balaclava and/or stocking cap
- Mittens

Wind Layer

- Winter jacket
- Snow pants
- Snow boots
- Sunglasses / skiing goggles / etc.

Other

- Water Bottle that can hold hot liquids
- Pocketknife
- Scout Handbook
- Personal First Aid Kit

Overnight Participants

- Sleeping Bag rated to at least 25 degrees below the forecasted weather
- Sleeping bag liner
- Sleeping bag pad
- Extra set of wicking and warmth layers
- Flashlight
- Other materials for sleeping overnight
- Mess Kit
