2025 Fall Camporee Troop Checklist

- 1) Bring a printed Roster to turn in at Registration to avoid delays.
- 2) Asking Units to park in grassy area behind maintenance building. Parking lot is being reserved for visitors coming for the day and Scouters that need to arrive or leave from Camp on Saturday.
- 3) Reminder – we will be staffing Admin gate and not allowing any traffic on road after Friday registration closes. Scouts can be dropped off and picked up at upper parking lot.
- 4) At the Adult leader meeting and SPL Cracker barrel we will have time for you to connect with station leaders and confirm availability for additional Scouts. Most stations will be unscheduled.
- 5) Reminder to be on time for Birthday Celebration, Cake, and Picture – *recommend Scouts pack a sack lunch to save time and eat close to program areas. (Review Heritage Tent flier with your unit)*
- 6) **We can use adult help** – either for a portion of the day or if you are going around with your Scouts. If you have Scouts in Shotgun the process will go quicker and Scouts will get more shooting if we have 2-3 more adults per session.
- 7) Review schedule with Scouts and ensure they know where they will be going.
- 8) Sign up for Campfire Skits/songs at cracker barrel if possible – no later than before morning flag. May need to limit to one skit/song per troop with additional slots possibly allowed for a second patrol from the larger troops.
- 9) Shotgun, Archery, BB-gun - make sure you have waiver forms to turn in at check-in
 - a. Scouts will receive additional wrist band to participate based on waiver
 - b. Limit shooting sports sign up to one event and shotgun to 12 unless they have previous experience. Will open up to multiple events the last week.
- 10) Please try to schedule the afternoon slots if they are not planning on participating in the fun run so that morning slots would be open for those participating.
- 11) Bring Chairs for campfire
- 12) If you have Scouts that would like to assist with the interfaith service on Saturday please let Tom DeMarais know – tom.demarais.bsa@gmail.com
- 13) Trading Post will be open the following hours:
 - a. Adults 11am – noon
 - b. Everyone noon – 1pm
 - c. Everyone 2pm – 5:30pm (will close briefly during evening flag)
