To make matter worse, Scoutmaster Terry L. Fossum and the others did this while dragging along a complete novice, someone who had never camped before in their life, 'kicking and screaming' across the finish line. It sounds like a recipe for disaster. Then again, so did Terry's life.

Growing up in the poorest city in the United States surrounded by gangs and drugs, Terry faced a life with few opportunities. One night he found himself starting down the barrel of an assault rifle. Instead of following a path toward a dark future, he joined Scouting. It changed his life.

Terry overcame great obstacles to earn a Mechanical Engineering degree from Texas A&M University. As an Officer in the U.S. Air Force, he received numerous awards, including Officer of the Year, Fairchild Air Force Base; Humanitarian of the Year, Strategic Air Command; and Distinguished Graduate, Squadron Officer's School.

In 1991, following his military service, Terry built a global direct sales business and became a multimillion-dollar earner.

Author of four books and a recognized leadership and self-improvement expert, Terry keynotes at corporate and organizational events and guest lectures at universities across the US and abroad. His latest, The Oxcart Technique -Blueprint for Success, hit #1 Bestseller on Wall Street Journal, Amazon, and Barnes & Noble, as well as bestseller on USA Today.

His philanthropic efforts span the globe including the Terry L. Fossum educational center in Rwanda, Africa, an agricultural training center in Malawi, Africa, scholarships for underprivileged youth, and more.

Terry has been involved in Scouting for over 40 years. An Eagle Scout as a Youth, he's served on all levels of scouting from Assistant Scoutmaster to District, and Council Levels. Among many others, he's earned the Outstanding Scouting Service Award, District Award of Merit, Silver Beaver, and OA's Vigil Honor. He is currently acting as Scoutmaster for Troop 400 in Spokane Valley, Washington. He enthusiastically credits scouting for shaping his life.

Terry has been the keynote speaker for diverse organizations such as New York Life, the Mays Business School MBA program, Washington Food Industry Association, the United States Air Force, Spokane Executive Women's International, Perione Produce Company, One Team Global, Girl Scouts of America, and Boy Scouts of America national conferences.
