Frequently Asked Questions

When is it?

Thursday June 8 - Saturday June 10

What time?

Check in 8:30 a.m.

Camp starts promptly at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. (Camp ends at Noon on Saturday but you and your family can stay at the pool as long as you wish after that.)

Where is it held?

Thursday and Friday: Webster County Fairgrounds, 614 North Marshall. Marshfield, MO

Saturday: Marshfield Public Pool, 1490 N Elm St, Marshfield, MO

What does it cost?

This year's cost is just \$40 per scout; \$10 per walking den leader/parent.

What will your scout need?

- If you haven't sent them in ahead of time, **everyone attending camp** must have bring a completed BSA Health form (Parts A & B only; no physical is needed). Contact Lee Roberts, if you are not sure if the forms have been sent in early or not.
- Each day every **scout, walking den leader** and **staff member** needs to bring a sack lunch, refillable water bottle, and comfortable closed-toe and closed-heel walking shoes. Apply sunscreen if needed.
- Coolers are available, so lunches should simply be packed in Ziploc or similar bags with your scout's first and last name written boldly across the front.

Where do I drop off and pick up my scout?

Every scout must be signed in and out by you, or your unit's designated leader. Check in/out takes place in the Centennial building located just south of the main arena. Scouts cannot be dropped off at the gates to the fairground.

What about bad weather?

We will hold camp rain or shine. We have plenty of pavilions to give shade and dry spaces. If storms approach, we have access to the large FEMA storm shelter located right on the fairgrounds.

Will my scout earn any belt loops while at camp?

Scouts will not do all the requirements to complete core or elective adventures, but they will complete many parts of a number of them. A complete list of what was achieved on each day will be provided to each unit leader at the end of camp.

What will your scout take home with them?

New Friendships, Positive Attitude, Great Scout Skills, Several Rank Advancement Requirements, Lifelong Memories & a Smile you will love to see at the end of each day!
