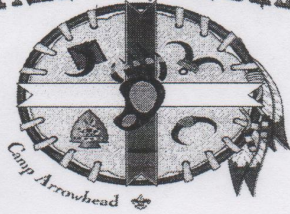

Called Coup

Minimum Requirements & Recommendation Form

General Requirements:

- Provided leadership to younger Scouts and has lived as a true Tribesman for the past year.
- Be attending an ENTIRE session of camp this year at Camp Arrowhead.
- Display Scout Spirit and good participation. The Scout lives the Scout Oath and Law in their daily life and participated in most unit meetings and activities this past year.

Coup to be awarded and requirements:

- Eagle Coup** - The Eagle Coup is awarded to any Tribesman (Brave or Warrior) who has earned the Eagle Scout rank. Braves who meet this requirement are eligible to be awarded this coup after becoming a Warrior.
- Religious Coup** - The Religious Coup is awarded to any Tribesman who has earned the BSA-recognized religious award for his or her faith. Braves who meet this requirement are eligible to be awarded this coup after becoming a Warrior.
- Coup of the Long Trail**
 - The Coup of the Long Trail is awarded to any Tribesman who carries the Spirit of Friendship and Warmth beyond the boundaries of Ozark Trails Council on a Scouting trip. However, if a Brave meets the requirements, the coup will only be awarded after he becomes a Warrior.
 - This form must be submitted to the Directing Medicine Man or a Directing Tribal Council Member *prior to going on this Scouting experience*.

- Dancer Coup**
 - Be a Hardway Warrior, Honorary Warrior, or Honored Woman. (* Braves are encouraged to work on all the other requirements so that the coup can be awarded when they become a warrior).
 - Learn about how to drum for dancing and learn about each of the dance styles:
 - Straight, Fancy, Northern Traditional, Grass, Ladies Cloth, Ladies Buckskin and Ladies Fancy Shawl
 - Discuss Powwow etiquette with the TOLB Dance adviser or earn the Indian Lore Merit Badge (if under 18 years old)
 - Construct an authentic outfit appropriate to your chosen style (required items list sheet for each style will be distributed upon request)
 - Learn how to dance in your chosen style.
 - Dance in at least 4 Lone Bear ceremonies (Hardway Warriors under 21 also perform the Sweet Grass Dance at one of the ceremonies)
 - Final approval - Lone Bear Dance Adviser or Directing or Recording Medicine Man

Tribe of Lone Bear Den Chief Coup

The Den Chief Coup is recognition by the Tribe of Lone Bear for all Tribesmen under 18, who actively participated as a Den Chief for one program year. The coup can be earned as a Brave but cannot be worn until becoming a Warrior in the Tribe. This coup will be presented each session at Camp Arrowhead.

This coup can only be earned by Tribesmen serving as a Den Chief **after June, 2020** and will be awarded to a Tribesman only one time.

Tribesmen seeking to earn this coup must meeting the following requirements:

1. Actively participate with a Den (Cub Scout or Webelos Den) for one program year in Den and Pack activities to the satisfaction of the Den Leader.
2. Completed Den Chief Training.
3. Completed form must be submitted to the Presiding Tribal Council Member at check-in on Day 1 of the Scout's camping session.
4. The form must be signed by the Den Chief's Scoutmaster and the Den Leader that worked with the Den Chief.
5. The form must be attached to the Den Chief Coup Call List form submitted by the Scoutmaster at check-in on Day 1 of your Troop's session at camp.

For a Scout to receive this recommendation, they must meet ALL the following requirements. If the Scout meets all the requirements, complete the below application.

- Be at least a Life Scout. All requirements for Life, including tenure and board of review must be completed before summer camp.
- To go through the Hardway program, he must be a Brave and under 18. If their 18th birthday occurs between June 1 and August 31, he may be recognized. If they are a Brave and over 18, they must go through the Honorary process.

- Be attending an ENTIRE session of camp this year at Camp Arrowhead.
- Display Scout Spirit and good participation. The Scout lives the Scout Oath and Law in their daily life and participated in most unit meetings and activities this past year.

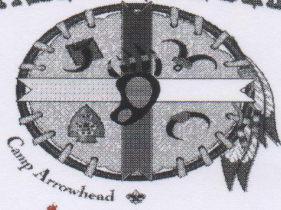

Minimum Requirements & Recommendation Form

Whether this recommendation is confidential is up to the discretion of the unit committee. The Tribal Council understands that adults may need to know about their recommendations in order to make sure they are in camp for the call, orientation and ceremony.

In order for a Scouter to receive this recommendation, they must meet ALL of the following requirements. If the Scouter meets all of the requirements, complete the below application.

- Must be a registered member of the Scouts BSA.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be trained for the position for which he or she is registered. This means all leaders must have completed Youth Protection training plus all position-specific training.
- Must be camping and giving leadership for this full session at Camp Arrowhead, or will have camped for a total of six nights at Camp Arrowhead summer camp sessions by the end of this session, counting this year and last year.
- Must attend the Call Night Ceremony on Monday, the orientation session on Tuesday morning, and the ceremonies on Thursday night.
- The unit committee must recommend a unit leader. The District Key Three may recommend a district leader. The Scout Executive may recommend a council board member, council officer, or a council staff member. The six-night camping requirement may be waived for a district-level or council-level volunteer or staff member.

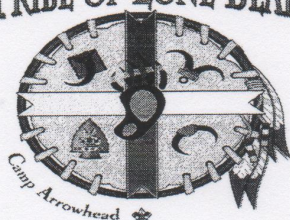

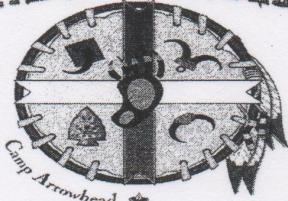

Youth Paint Recognition

Minimum Requirements & Recommendation Form

This form is **CONFIDENTIAL** and should not be discussed with the Scout.
No Scout should know whether they are being recommended.

For a Scout to receive this recommendation, they must meet ALL following requirements that pertain to them. If the Scout meets all the requirements, complete the below application.

- Given leadership to younger Scouts and displayed Scout Spirit – meaning they lived the Scout Oath and Law in their daily life.
- Be attending an ENTIRE session of camp this year at Camp Arrowhead.

Choose one of the following:

Under 18 years of age Hardway Warrior must meet ALL of the following requirements:

- Must be a Hardway Warrior.
- They must have participated this past year in a majority (more than half) of their unit's meetings and other activities intended for all troop members, AND a majority (more than half) of their troop's overnight campouts.
 - Meetings and activities that are counted must be those that are intended for all troop members. Patrol Leaders Council, patrol meetings, Order of the Arrow, National Youth Leadership Training, Philmont high adventure trips, and Jamborees are activities for certain boys and are not counted toward meeting the troop leadership participation requirement. Also, a majority is more than half. Attending five campouts out of 10 possible is half, not a majority, and does not meet the requirement.
- May receive paint recognition with the approval of the unit committee.

18-20 years of age Hardway Warrior must meet ALL of the following requirements:

- Must be under 21 years of age. If a Tribesman's 21st birthday falls between June 1 and August 31 of the current camping season, they may be recommended.
- Must be trained for the position for which he or she is registered. This means all leaders must have completed Youth Protection training plus all position-specific training. All of these courses are available online.
- Must have participated this past year in 55% of their unit's meetings and other activities, AND a majority (more than half) of the overnight campouts intended for the entire unit. That means that outings such as high adventure trips, leadership training, and Jamborees do not count for the camping requirement because they're not for the entire unit. Also, a majority is more than half. Attending five campouts out of 10 possible is half, not a majority, and does not meet the requirement.
- The Tribesman must gain the approval of a majority of the Tribal Council at camp. Tribal Council members will observe their leadership while they are at camp.

NOTE: If the Tribesman is away at school, they must give leadership to a unit in their school's community for 55% of its meetings and activities. Their home unit must verify this activity in writing prior to submitting this recommendation. In the unlikely event that this Scouter is not living near an active Scout troop and can't return to their home troop to provide leadership on a regular basis, the troop committee could apply for an exception by certifying this young man provided a significant amount of leadership for some other youth group or community organization where they live. The Tribal Council at camp will vote on whether this young man will be elevated.

If the unit committee feels there should be an exception to the participation requirement or the requirement for attending an ENTIRE session this year, please attach a letter stating the reason for the request. The Tribal Council at camp during that session will vote on whether this Scout should be elevated.
