Please eat dinner before arriving to Encampment as it will not be provided Friday evening. Please arrive as close as possible between 6:00 and 6:45 p.m., and try to be there before dusk. If you will be arriving later than 8:00 p.m. on Friday, please let us know so we can make accommodations.

Included below is a recommended packing list for Ordeal Candidates:

Bag #1 for Friday night:

- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping pad (optional)
- Tarp (large enough to wrap around you at least once is **highly** recommended)
- Water bottle
- Work gloves
- Small First Aid kit (somewhat optional as we do have a medic on camp)
- Work clothes (if you wish to change clothes on Saturday morning)

*Only bring what you are willing to carry and need for one night. Some only bring a tarp and their water!

**You will not need your phone for the first night as you will have a guide with you.

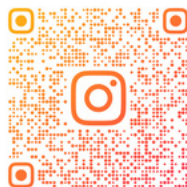
Bag #2 for Saturday:

- Toiletry kit
- Field Uniform (Class A)
- Wallet (for the Trading Post and Auction)
- Vehicle keys (if you drove)
- Cell Phone

*The items listed above are solely Ordeal items. Please do not bring a tent, food or a flashlight to the Ordeal itself. You will need a tent and your Class A on Saturday, so leave those with your unit, not locked in your car.
