Funds available for camperships covered by this application come from funds restricted by the council or donated by individuals for the use of Scouts attending camping activities at Camp Geiger and District Day Camps.

The Council Camping Committee is concerned about the individual needs and the unit's individual evaluation of the Scout for whom this request is made.

Generally, camperships are limited to no more than 75% of the activity cost. Each Scout, his family or his unit should provide a minimum of 25% of the activity cost.

Applications must be submitted by April 1st. Applications received after April 1st will be reviewed but may not be granted due to lack of funds. Camperships are not transferable, refundable and have no cash value. All information in this application will be treated confidentially.

Please list the amount or portion of the cost provided by the Scout, the family, the unit and/or the chartered organization to arrive at the amount requested.

The ninth part of the Scout Law is "A Scout is THRIFTY." A Scout works to pay his own way.

The Council Camping Committee is very interested in what the Scout has done to assist his family in providing him with this camping experience. This is a character building opportunity for the Scout to learn the importance of being THRIFTY.
