Fishing Tournament Information:

- Fishing for all species of fish in the lake.
- You may keep anything you catch but YOU have to clean, prep & cook.
- Meal Worms will be provided. You may use artificial bait or bring your own.
- Bring your own fishing rods and tackle, Camp Lewallen has some if you don't.
- Judging will be based on fish length & quantity.
- Measured fish must be caught by rod and reel.
- **Registration**, Lake Potashnick Pavilion, 8:00 - 8:30 AM
- **Receive Bait & Gear** if needed 8:30 - 9:00
- **Fish** 9:00 - 11:30
- **Lunch** 11:30 - 12:00 pm
- **Awards** 3:30 pm Dining Hall by Flags.

 - Longest Catfish
 - All Around Longest Fish
 - Most Fish Caught
 - If I can get enough awards Cub and Scouts BSA will be separate.
- Each scout will be issued an ID card.
- Each troop or volunteer will be issued a measuring device
- When a scout catches a fish a troop adult or volunteer will measure and take a picture of the fish on the measuring device with the scout's ID card. This photo will be sent to the judges via text message. Phone Number will be provided at registration.
- Judges will record the measurement on a tracking sheet.
