All Scouts BSA Scouts and Venturers are invited to take part in the 11th Annual Trades Day at Rhodes France Scout Reservation. This is a unique experience for Scouts to learn valuable skills related to various skilled trades and possible career opportunities all while earning a merit badge. Scouts will work on one merit badge throughout the weekend. These courses will be in-depth and very hands-on and include some off-site trips to local businesses.

Check-in will begin at 8:30am on Saturday, August 24th with the merit badge sessions beginning at 9:00am. Lunch will be provided for all registered participants. Scouts should have and have read the Merit Badge Pamphlet for their class. This will be a one day event concluding about 4 pm.

It is important that each Scout read through the merit badge pamphlet prior to the event. Scouts must arrive at camp with the pre-requisites completed. Many of the merit badges require long pants and sturdy shoes to complete the tasks safely.

Electricity - Prerequisites: #1, #2



Farm Mechanics - Prerequisites - #7, Dress to be in an implement shop for hands on repairs.



Home Repairs - Prerequisites: 1a, 1b Dress to work on repair projects.

Welding Prerequisites: #1, #7. Wear jeans and heavy shoes. Bring long sleeve shirt for welding. Scouts must be 13 or older to take this merit badge.
