What is Call of the Wild?

A Saturday morning through Sunday morning camp out experience designed for Cub Scouts and their families.

Who is invited?

Lions, Tigers, Wolves, Bears and their Cub Scout age siblings along with their adults

Why not Webelos or Arrow of Light?

They have their specialized program at Fall Camporee with the Scouts, BSA..

What goes on at Call of the Wild?

Each rank moves through sessions to earn 4 Adventures.

After the sessions, there is time to set up camp with your family and pack before Campfire.

Once Campfire has concluded, it's lights out.

Highlights of session activities:

Hiking, crafts, whittling, birdhouse building, fishing, learning to camp, camp songs, etc. (activities are based on which adventures are being earned)

Lions and Tigers

Lions and Tigers's adult partners are required to participate with them throughout the event.

Where does Call of the Wild take place?

Cub World at Beaumont Scout Reservation off Hwy 44 in High Ridge, MO. Scouts will have access to the Pirate Ship, Mine, and playground.

What do we eat?
