Training Schedule and Information

March 29, 2025 (Spring): Camp Warren Levis, Godfrey, IL at Taste of Venturing

May 3, 2025 (Spring) and October 4, 2025 (Fall – Tentative): Beaumont Scout Reservation, High Ridge MO

Saturday – meet at 8am at climbing tower site at each property. At all trainings, you will learn the operations of the Beaumont, Camp Lewallen and the newly refurbished Camp Warren Levis towers (Camp Warren Levis tower opened June 2021).

The training lasts until 1pm; bring lunch and plenty of water.

For Beaumont Training ONLY: Starting at 1pm, everyone participating in the training will need to have **TWO YOUTH** arrive, who will give participants the opportunity to demonstrate the climbing instructor skills learned in the morning. We expect to wrap up by 5pm.

At the end of the training and skills demonstration on training day, participants will receive a 2-year certification card to be a Climbing Instructor for our three climbing towers.

Tower training qualifies you to take your Cub Scout, Scouts BSA or Venturing unit climbing at our council's tower climbing program sites.

Cub Scouts are permitted to climb on towers ONLY. Cub Scouts are not permitted to rappel at any program site, or to climb on natural climbing sites. Find out more at https://stlbsa.org/training/challenge-course-climbing/

Climbing Tower Instructor Training General Information

The Saturday morning training course is required to become a Qualified Climbing Tower Instructor for the Greater St. Louis Area Council sites. You will receive site specific training for the climbing towers at Beaumont, Camp Lewallen, and Camp Warren Levis. Tower training qualifies you to take your unit climbing at all council climbing tower sites. Saturday starting at 1pm, participants will need to demonstrate skills prior to being certified.

Instructors interested in leading rappelling on the Beaumont climbing tower will need to complete the separate Rock Climbing & Rappelling Training (Scouts BSA or Venturing only, Cub Scouts are not permitted to rappel).

Adults must be at least 18 years old to take training.

Fitness: The training is very active and high energy. There is no sitting around and it is all outdoors, rain or shine. Don't sign up thinking this will be lectures or classroom work!

FEES: \$25 includes notebook and patch.
