Raingutter Regatta Build Requirements

The race is not just for speed. Boats will race from one end to the other of the track. The scouts will then load the ship with 'raided loot' for the race back to the start. Prizes will be awarded for the fastest ship, the most loot returned home and the best build to Viking theme. Troops may have multiple entries.

Boat Build Specifics

- **Boat Should follow Viking Style Visually:** However actual boat style is open within size restrictions. Multi-hull designs (catamarans, trimarans) are permitted.
- **Maximum Length:** 12 in with minimum 7in (including rudder/fin if present).
- **Maximum Width:** Must fit freely within the 8 in track—recommended hull width is less than 4 in to avoid gutter friction and maximize speed.
- **Maximum Mast Height:** 12 in, measured from the deck to the top of the mast.
- You may use wood, plastic, or other common boat-building materials.
- Any lightweight, non-cup-shaped sail material may be used (paper, fabric, thin plastic, etc.).
- Sail should be proportionate to the mast and must not be more than 6 in,
- Shaping the sail for decoration and streamlining is allowed; shaping into a "cup" or receptacle for blowing is not.
- No additional ballast/weight required, but boat should be balanced for straight tracking.
- Rudder/keel are optional. If present, must not add to overall length beyond 12 in.
- Paint and decorations permitted if firmly attached. Viking theme is encouraged.
- Decorations must NOT extend outside the maximum dimensions.
- Boat must float and sail (be propelled by blowing).
- Boat should be constructed primarily by the scouts/participants, with adult supervision as needed.
- NO MOTORS. SHIP BREATH PROPELLED BY BREATH OR FAN PROVIDED ALONE.

Troop Flag & Viking Contest

To 'go viking' was to explore. That is how the Scandinavian explorers came to be know as Vikings. Their ships and shields boldly and proudly announced who they were for all to see. We want our units to honor exploring as Vikings by creating flags to carry and display at the Camporee.

- No smaller than pillowcase
- No larger than what scouts can carry all day
- Flagpole material open for troop choice.
- Must include Troop number. If a Troop has flags per patrol, patrol number/ name or emblem must be on flag as well.
- Should be multicolored, bright and vibrant to be easily identified from a distance. Like Viking sails seen across the sea.
- Troop or Patrol Yells encouraged during the day.
- Singing songs and chanting while walking to events is encouraged. Viking theme is encouraged.
