

Pre-Camp Swim Classification Tests

This is an opportunity for your unit to have your annual Scouting America swim classification check done under the supervision of GSLAC-approved aquatics personnel at the Beaumont pool. A unit swim classification record will be issued by GSLAC Aquatics personnel to each unit showing the swim classification (swimmer, beginner, non-swimmer) of each participant. This event is open to all GSLAC units (Pack, Troops, and Crews), both youth and adults.

Units must register online at stlbsa.org/training for a 30-minute block. Up to 20 tests can be administered during a block. Available times start at 12:00pm: 12:00-12:30, 12:30-1:00, 1:00-1:30, 2:00-2:30, 2:30-3:00, 3:30-4:00. Cost is \$8 per participant. Minimum preregistration is 10 per unit. Smaller groups will be handled on a walk-in, pay-onsite, space available basis. The registration deadline is April 27.

Note: Although these swim tests are being conducted prior to summer camp, the camp aquatics director is expected to review or retest any scout or leader whose skills appear to be inconsistent with his classification. Additionally, the camp aquatics program director is authorized to retest any Scout or group of Scouts at his/her discretion.
