# Camp Rules and Regulations

**Camp Code** the Scout Oath, Scout Law, and the Outdoor Code

**Roster** The troop roster, enclosed with this packet, will be filled out and turned into HQ upon registration. Make additional copies if needed.

(You may bring your own roster from Troop's database.)

**Generators** will be permitted but must remain off in between the hours of 10:30 p.m. and 6:30 a.m.

**Cooking Fuels** All flammable liquids must be under adult control and supervision.

**Pressurized Fuels** All pressurized fuels must be locked away safely while not in use. Refer to the "Guide to Safe Scouting" and your pressurized fuel training.

**Use of Water** sources are only for filling containers. They are not to be used for personal hygiene, washing, or rinsing dishes, or washing clothes.

**Ground Fires** Ground fires are permitted, only they must be set up in the fire rings.

**Tent Pitching** Proper pitching avoids 'ditching'. Digging ditches around tents is prohibited.

**Garbage** A dumpster is located at Swaim Lodge for trash. Do not bury garbage.

**Tobacco** No person under the age of 18 is allowed to use or possess tobacco products. Adults are encouraged to refrain from using tobacco products, but if they do, use them away from all youth and event areas. Violators will be asked to leave.

**Alcohol and Drugs** Alcoholic beverages and non-medically prescribed drugs are not allowed on council property or at council activities. Violators will be asked to leave.

**Sheath Knives** are not allowed.

**Fireworks & Firearms:** Fireworks and firearms are not permitted. Violators will be asked to leave.

**Pets** are not allowed on Council property. Service animals are welcome.

**Early Arrivals** Please DO NOT arrive before 4:30 PM

**School v. Scouts** All scouts should complete their school schedule before departing for the Camporee.

# Morning Stations

## **The One that Got Away (Req #6 & #8)**

Help Minecraft Steve play a game of Family Feud. Test your fishing knowledge of the Outdoor Code, Leave No Trace, catch and release, and sportsmanship principles.

## **Safety with Steve (Req #1)**

Help Steve stay safe while fishing outdoors by testing your knowledge of first aid, hazards, and safety procedures.

## **Fitted Diamond Fishers (Req 2 & 3)**

Make sure the villagers are prepared for fishing in all types of weather and with different types of equipment. Be prepared to demonstrate your knowledge of how to use and care for the different equipment (equipment provided).

## **Alex is Knot up to it (Req #4)**

Alex is tangled up in her fishing line. Help him learn the proper knots by demonstrating your knowledge of the following: Improved Clinch Knot, Palomar knot, uni knot, uni to uni knot, and arbor knot, and when to use each one.

**BOOK AND Quill** – Villagers will obtain their book and Quill by documenting the species of trees, Shrubs, or fruiting bodies found in the forest near the village.

**Ring the Bells** – There is a sickness in the village's trees, preventing the harvest of high-quality honey. Find the root of the problem and report to the Cleric.

**Farmer 101** – Endangered species, plants, and animals are affecting our crops! Social well-being, including but not limited to recreation, soil development, and blooming fertility, and our water is depleted! Villagers needed to educate and grow our crops!

## **Pre-req/Outside Work: Cook & Clean - Lunch Hour**

Your fishing trip was cut short by evil villagers. Bring photos of you/your troop cleaning and cooking fish that was either caught or acquired. This can be done at Lunch or another time.

# Afternoon Stations

**Only You Can Prevent Forest Fires** – Your team is tasked with supervising the forest and wood-chopping operations. Learn and demonstrate how forest management relates to sustainability, silvicultural systems, burning, and forest management practices.

**Forest Marketplace** - There was a post logging operation, and the villagers have a need for new sticks to sell. Where do the trees come from, and where are they going?

**Watch Out For That Tree!** - Look up and be aware! What hazards do you see in your campgrounds? Why should you be vigilant in setting up camp?

**Where did the Forest Go?** Learn how to care for the forest and why it is slowly disappearing. What can you do?

## **I'll Bait; You'll Love it. (Req #5)**

Help the Villagers build their trade empire with fishing bait and lures.

## **Fish On! (Req #9)**

The villagers' market ran out of fish! Help them restock by catching more. Make sure you can tell them what kind it is.

## **Fear the Fishing Golem (Req #7)**

Your travels have led you into a detailed and complex fishing village. Now you have to learn all their rules and regulations, so you don't have to face the Fishing Golem
