- Completed/signed BSA Health & Medical forms A, B, C (dated no earlier than 6/24/2023)
- Complete Scout field uniform for check-in, ceremonies, and special activities (Scout shirt required; Scout pants are highly recommended)
- Pants, socks (wool recommended), and underwear for 6 days
- 2 Scout Class-B t-shirts for activities (each Scout will receive 1 NYLT t-shirt and cap at check-in; additional t-shirts may be purchased on the registration site)
- Long sleeve polar fleece pullover or jacket
- Set of sleeping clothes, socks, and knit cap (for sleeping only)
- Rain gear (waterproof jacket/coat with hood and pants)
- Gloves/mittens
- Hiking boots/shoes (no Crocs or open-toe shoes for activities)
- Day pack for daily activities and ten essentials
- Small notebook and pencils
- Personal first aid kit, moleskin, etc.
- Medications (labeled in their original containers, to be turned in to the Health Officer at check-in)
- Personal care items (small towel/chamois, shower shoes, soap, deodorant, hygiene products, toothbrush/toothpaste, sunscreen, Chapstick, comb/brush, glasses/sunglasses, etc.)
- Sleeping bag and liner in a waterproof bag
- Extra synthetic/fleece blanket
- Sleeping pad (full length)
- Flashlight and extra batteries (for use at night and in tent)
- Watch and compass
- Water bottle
- Backpack for outpost hike (recommended to pack gear for the week, too)
- Backpacking tent (1-2 person) and ground cloth (for 1-night outpost campout)
- Mess kit (for 1-night outpost campout)
- Optional: The course theme this year is Superheros, so anything (backpack-able) that fits the theme (capes, pins, headwear, notebook, etc)

Please make sure you bring warm gear. K-M Scout Ranch is in the Moccasin Mountains near Lewistown, and temperatures/rain are chilly in June.
