Adults and Scouts need to have long PANTS, a brimmed hat, water bottle, and closed toed shoes every day of camp.

As a reminder Medical forms (for Scout and Parent) need to be handed into the Scout Office by Friday June 6th at 5pm.

Dear Campers:

We want to take a moment and welcome you to the Black Otter District's Cub Scout Day Camp! This letter contains a lot of information: be sure to read through this thoroughly. Please do not hesitate to call us with any questions.

Location:

All Day Camps are located in Lockwood, one mile north of the Pictograph Caves on Coburn Road. You will need to turn south off the Old Hardin Road to the West of the Cenex truck stop. You will turn onto Coburn Road and drive for approximately 4.1 miles. The camp will be on the left-hand side of the road. Please drive carefully; although the camp is fenced, it parallels the road and safety is our first concern.

Checking In At Camp:

On the first day of camp those attending camp will check in at Headquarters. You will receive a camp shirt. These need to be worn the entire time you are on camp property. **Allow extra time to park your vehicle after dropping off your Scouts and picking up your Scout(s).** Expect to be greeted by a Ranger or Boy Scout in an orange vest to escort your Scout across the road into camp. Youths are not allowed to walk along the road due to heavy traffic.

The gate will be open at 8:45 on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday & 11:45 on Friday for drop off.

What to bring- requirements for Cub Scout and Volunteers

Long pants	Medical Forms at the office (both A and B)
Closed-Toed Shoes- tennis shoes	Sack meal (lunch)
Hat with bill to shield face (no visors)	Daypack
Water bottle filled with water	Bug Spray & Sunscreen (labeled with name)

Medication

- All Prescription Medicine must come in its original bottle prescribed by the physician.
- Over the counter medication brought to camp must be in its original bottle and labeled with the Scout's name.
- Special instructions, signed by the parent/guardian must accompany the medications.
- All medications will be held and distributed by the Camp Medics at the prescribed times.
- National Camp Guidelines states The Camp Medical Officer must collect all youth medications and store them in a locked container. With the exception of life threatening illnesses. Epi-pens and Inhalers may stay with campers, however, must be shown to the Camp Medics.
- If a Scout is supposed to have an Epi-pen or inhaler on them and arrives at camp without one, they will be held from all activities, for their safety, until the item has been obtained or a parent is contacted to clear the matter.
- Please apply Sunscreen and insect repellent prior to arriving at camp. Sunscreen and repellent brought to camp must be labeled with Scout's name and any special instructions. Camp policy is to keep these items at the First Aid Station, and Camp Medics will dispense as needed.

Day Camp has a NO SMOKING, VAPING, or TOBACCO POLICY- Please leave these items in your vehicles prior to entering camp. If you are in need of a break, let Headquarters know so that we can find coverage for you. These breaks must occur in your car. This policy is established by our National Boy Scouting Office and ***is strongly*** enforced.

We again want to welcome you to Cub Scout Day Camp, and we hope you will have a pleasant adventure. As a reminder, your Tiger Scouts must be accompanied by an adult at all times. If there is anything we can do for you, please feel free to contact us at any time.
