



# Race Rules

**ALL CARS MUST PASS INSPECTION TO QUALIFY FOR THE RACE.**

The following are inspection points:

1. Construction of ALL entries MUST have begun AFTER last year's races - or - cars must be built new for this season and cannot have been raced in previous years.
2. The car weight shall not exceed 5.0 ounces. The official race scale shall be considered final.
3. The overall length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
4. The overall width of the car shall not exceed 2 3/4 inches.
5. The car must have 1 3/4 inches clearance between the wheels.
6. The car must have 3/8-inch clearance underneath the body.
7. The wood provided in the kit must be used. The block may be shaped any way that is desired.
8. The wheels supplied with the kit must be used. The wheels may not be cut, drilled, beveled or rounded. All 4 wheels must be able to touch the track surface. You may remove the seam from the wheels.
9. The axles supplied with the kit must be used. They may be polished. Wheel bearings, washers or bushings are prohibited.
10. The car must not ride on any springs.
11. The car must be freewheeling, with no starting devices.
12. No loose material of any kind, such as lead shot, may be used.

Each car must pass inspection by the Official Inspection Committee before it will be allowed to compete. All participants with cars not passing inspection will be notified and asked how they wish to proceed. Cars will be allowed to race but will not qualify for a trophy if it does not pass.

Prizes: Medals and trophies will be awarded based on race results
