

Personal Equipment List

(Note: Adjust to suit the needs of each course and each portion of the course.)

Required

- Full official Scout uniform(s) for your current Scouting position (Note: A complete uniform includes the official shirt; shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes; socks; and belt. A neckerchief and slide will be provided.)
- Scout activity uniform(s) Official pants, skirt, or culottes; socks; belt; and a Scouting t-shirt or other Scouting shirt
- Shoes or boots appropriate for camp
- Scout cap, if desired
- Windbreaker or jacket
- Rain gear (poncho or rain suit)
- Underwear
- Sleeping clothes
- Handkerchief or bandana
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Tent with mosquito netting
- Ground pad, air mattress, or cot
- Sleeping bag
- Flashlight or headlamp with spare batteries
- Pocketknife or multiple tool-type knife (no fixed-blade knives)
- Medication in labeled containers
- Toiletries
- Towels and washcloths
- Pens, pencils
- Water bottle
- Backpack for carrying your gear to and from the site of the outdoor experience
- Handbook for your Scouting program
