Who Can Attend

Scouts in Lions thru Arrow of Light are welcome to attend. If you would like to bring a friend to show them what scouting is all about feel free to invite them. They need to register as a "Non-Cub Youth".

Adult Leaders

In accordance with Youth Protection Policies, each unit MUST provide a minimum of two-deep active leadership for this event.

If a scout is coming without a unit, they must have their own active legal guardian with them for the day.

Adult assistance is required to keep the youth safe, plan on joining the scouts at all activities.

Health Forms

Every participant must provide a completed copy of their Annual Health and Medical form parts A & B; signed by the appropriate person as well as a copy of their insurance card. These will be returned at the end of the session.

Lunch on Saturday will be provided. If a unit or family camps for the weekend, you will be in charge of all of the other meals on your own.

Check-in Procedures

Arrive anytime between 8:00 - 9:00 am.

Adult leader will check-in with the activity leadership and get your packet. You will also turn in your health forms at this time. Please make sure if you bring non scouting youth you have a health form for them as well.

After checking in, the pack will proceed to the assigned staging area.

Check out with the activity leadership to pick up your health forms and any other materials. Have a safe trip home.

Themes

At the time of this posting, the new cub program has not officially been released. The leadership intent is to cover some of the general knowledge areas based on location. If we can cover an cub scout elective we will do our best.

Liberty Cove will be covering the hiking pocket segment. Grab your Cub Scout Six Essentials and lace up your hiking shoes. **A special summertime backpack will be provided to all youth.**

Sandy Channel will be covering the fishing pocket segment. Bring your fishing gear if you have it. We will have equipment to loan too. **A special tackle box will be provided to all youth.**

Fort Kearney will be covering the bike pocket segment. Bring your bicycle, helmet, and safety gear. We will do a safety check of the bikes before starting, then hit the Kearney bike trail for the day. **A special geocaching surprise will be provided to all youth.**

All three locations have geocaching available. Some additional special cub scout geocaches will be placed.

Cub Scout Grand Slam

The Cub Scout Summertime Fun Award is open to any scout that participates in three Cub Scout Activities anytime during the months of May through August. Any combination of these 3 fun days or 2 and the May 4 STAR Camp will earn this award.

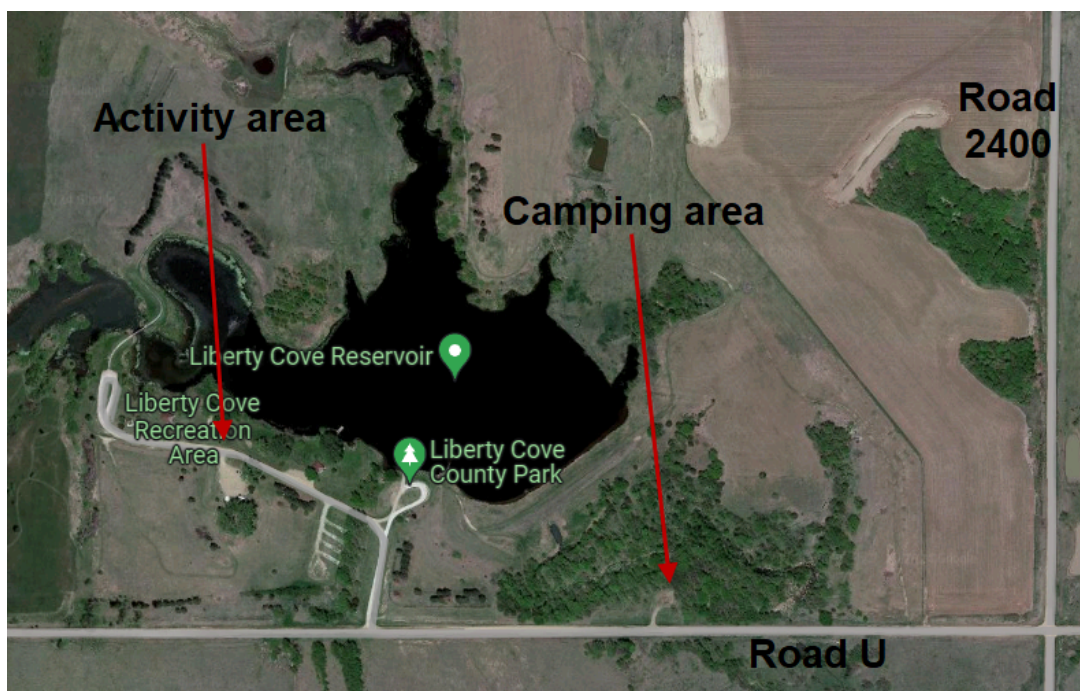
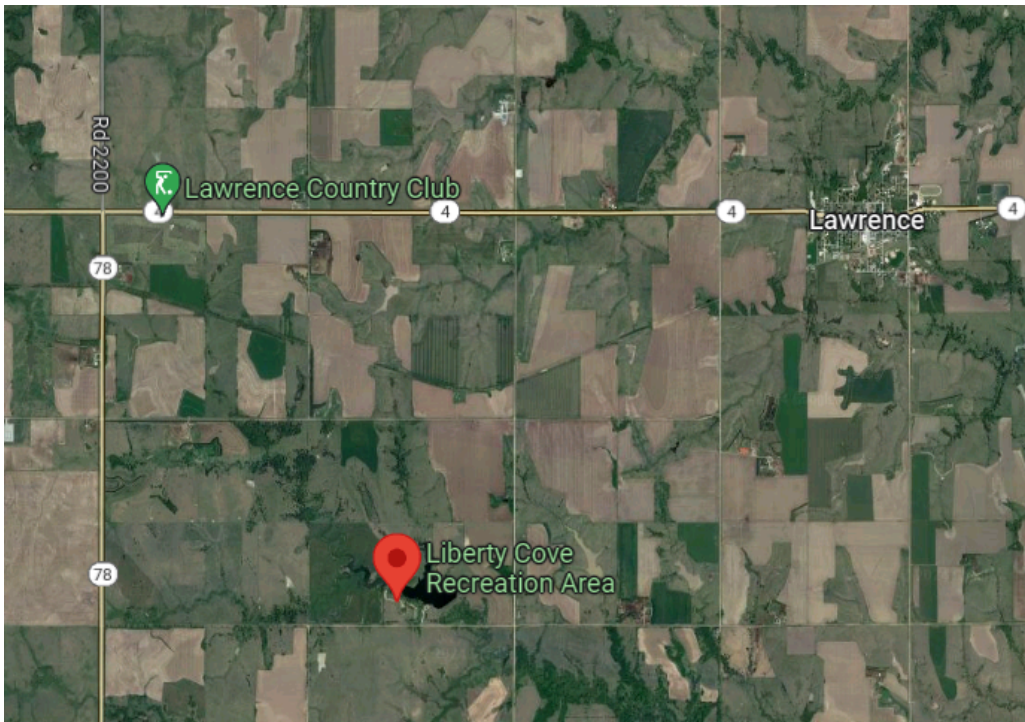
Refund Policy

Refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Fees may be transferred to another Scout or Adult if done before the end of the regular registration period. After that, all refund requests must be in writing. All refund requests must be done on the form available on the Overland Trails Council website. 25% of the fee is non-refundable if the fee is not transferred to another Scout or Adult's registration. All refund requests must be made within 30 days of the event.

June 15, 2024

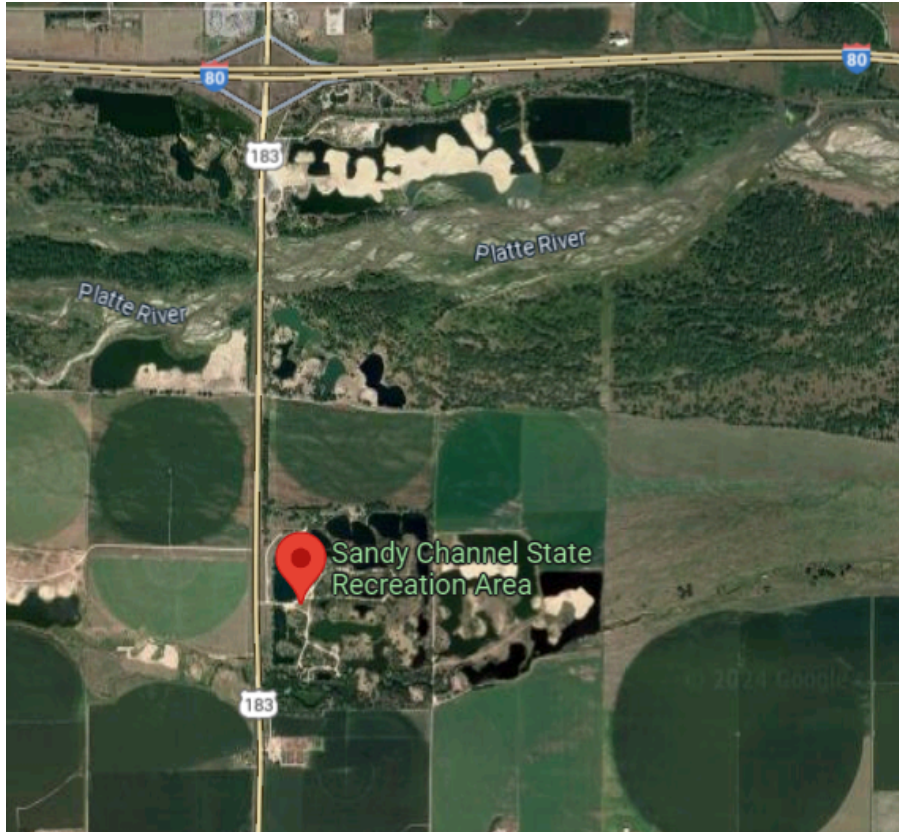
Liberty Cove Recreation Area is located 2 miles east and 2 miles south of Lawrence, Nebraska. The camping area and the program activity are close to each other. Take Hwy 4 to Road 2400. Turn west on Road U.



Sandy Channel Fun Day

July 20, 2024

Sandy Channel is located south of Interstate 80, on Hwy 183. "The Elm Creek exit."



Fort Kearney Fun Day

August 24, 2024

Fort Kearney Scout Area is located directly north of the Fort Kearney State Historical Park (NOT the State Recreation Area). Take Highway 50A.
