Ordeal: Ordeal is the first level of membership in the Order. In order to become a member, a candidate must go through an ordeal so they can be tested on all points of loyalty and fidelity, which our brotherhood is founded upon. They spend a night under the stars, cheerfully participate in a day of service, bound in silence, and live on scant food so they can turn their thoughts inward.



Brotherhood: To become a Brotherhood member, an Ordeal member must wait at least 10 months. Brotherhood membership is earned only by the Ordeal member himself or herself. They will be reviewed on their knowledge of the Obligation, Song, and History of the Order, as well as other things. Once a member has become a Brotherhood, his or her membership is completely sealed in the Order.
