Because I know many are new and many are also traveling significant distances to Usher I need to make it abundantly clear that a full /official uninform is mandatory to be admitted to usher. I do not want to have you arrive to usher only to be turned away because of misunderstanding. See pictures below

Also please note:

Memorial Stadium Policy notice and review for Scout Ushers

1. Scout ushers and other Stadium Staff including concessions workers are prohibited by Memorial Stadium policy from taking personal photos or videos inside or outside of the stadium on game day. Scout ushers are prohibited inside and outside of the stadium from requesting autographs. Violations of these policies are grounds for immediate dismissal from the scout ushering program.
2. There are no Boy Scout Usher positions in premium level areas (club and suite levels). All Scout Ushers should be in the main seating bowl and the upper 600 east stadium locations. If there have been positions in premium levels in years past, I'm respectfully asking that we pull these and focus on our main bowl and upper 600 east level. The need for ushering is within our general public seating areas, not the premium levels as those levels have their own built-in hosts.

Below you will find pictures of what a Full uniform looks like, An ushering hat will be provided if you do not already have one from a previous season, if you need a belt and are wearing a belt it must be BSA Branded, either web or leather (BSA camp /high adventure/jamboree belts and buckles that are BSA commemorative are acceptable) BSA or venturing socks must be worn when in shorts, or Short pants/capris etc. In other words if your socks can be seen then they must be official to the uniform you are wearing.
