

## 2020 Cornhusker Council Scouts BSA Resident Camp Refund Policy – Revised 5-7-2020

Cornhusker Council absolutely recognizes that employment, vacations, and worries may prohibit your unit's attendance at Camp Cornhusker in 2020. For this reason, you may request the following via USPS in writing to John Sumner:

- Units and or individuals: who notify the council in writing via USPS prior to June 1 will receive A 100% refund of all fees and deposits – **to be fair to the Cornhusker Council, these requests MUST be submitted by June 1.** After June 1, if we are permitted to institute our revised 2020 camp plan by advice of Medical Advisors, State and Local Officials, materials will be purchased and ordered to support your attendance.

If Authorities and wisdom dictate that camp operations are not feasible, you will receive a 100% refund. Refund allocations will begin on or after June 15, 2020. Please allow 10-15 business days after that date to process your request.

- **Units** Cancelling with notification after June 1 and **Prior to June 15**: Cornhusker Council will refund all but \$60.00 per person to offset purchases already made on behalf of your unit.
- **No Show Units**: If your unit fails to notify Cornhusker Council of cancellations and does not check into camp at the appropriate time, your unit will forfeit any and all fees.
- **Individual No Shows without notification prior to Camp**: Individual Scout's whose parents prohibit his/her attendance after the unit has communicated its intention to attend and does not notify Cornhusker Council by July 1, will forfeit 75% of the fees paid by the unit for that Scout and a refund will be issued for the balance to the unit account at the OEC.
- **Postponement**: You may choose to move your camp deposit of 200.00 per unit toward reservations in 2021. If you choose to do that, you will receive the balance of the payments paid by your unit. You may do this whether YOU cancel your plans or if Cornhusker Council cancels summer operations.
