- 1. Whitlin Chip Corey Viehl (1 hour) This will help familiarize a new or experienced leader in the current requirements for the Whittling Chip. Learn tips and tricks to ensure success in your den or patrol level instruction.
- 2. Knots Robert Davis (30 minutes) Learn what a knot is and isn't. Learn 6 knots and 5 lashings and take the red rope challenge.
- 3. Fire building and safety Martin "Porkchop" Kahland (30 minutes) Learn different ways to start a fire and fire safety.
- 4. Fire arm\firing range safety D J Davis (30 minutes) Learn what is available for youth, ages 7-18, at the firing range. Learn the safety rules and requirements for use of the firing range at the OEC and at Camp Cornhusker.
