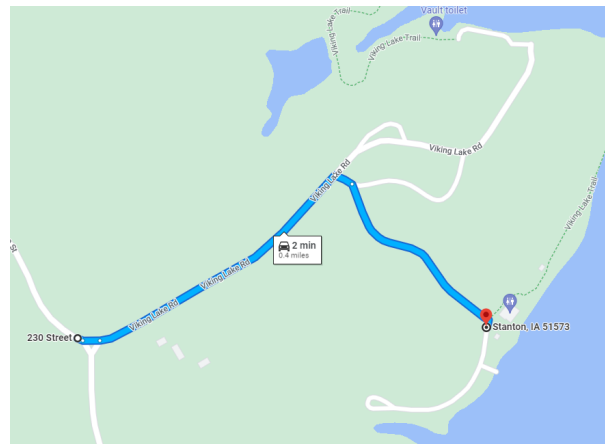

Directions to Viking Lodge

When entering the Viking Lake State Park on 230th Street

- Turn left (northeast) on Viking Lake Road.
- Travel 1,300 feet on Viking Lake Road
- Turn right (southeast).
- Stay right and follow the road to the parking area.
- Additional parking can be found past the boat ramps - please do not block the road.



Check-In/ Check-out

Check-in is from 8:30 am to 9:00 am. If you arrive before 8:30 am, you are free to wait at the parking lot or explore the park. For any late arrivals, check-in will still be at Viking Lodge and a volunteer will direct you from there.

Everyone will need a copy of their [BSA Health Form Parts A and B](#). This includes youth AND adults. Please have the health forms for each person completed and available upon check-in. T-Shirts for those who pre-purchased or registered before our t-shirt deadline can be picked up during check-in.

Once camp concludes at 4:00 pm, please go to the Viking Lodge to check-out. If at any time you need to check-out early, please find Richard Maisel.

Program

Program will begin at 9:00 AM on Saturday and will conclude at 4:00 PM.

Participants will be divided into groups and then guided through the following activities:

Vehicles on Camp

There is no vehicle permit or entrance fee for entering Viking Lake State park. Please park in the parking lot at Viking Lodge and avoid parking along the road.

Health & Safety

All campers (youth and adults) must have a BSA Health Form (parts A & B) completed and brought to camp with them. Each camper should keep this form on them at all times. We will not be collecting them during check in.

There is no swimming allowed for all camp participants during the program.

What to Bring

All participants must have closed toed shoes.

Remember your Cub Scout Six Essentials - bring a full water bottle, sun protection, and your first aid kit.

There may be some precipitation throughout the day, so it'd be a good idea to bring a rain jacket. In the event of inclement weather, programs may be adjusted or moved to different areas underneath the picnic shelter and/or in the Viking Lodge.

Fishing poles will be provided during the event, but feel free to bring your own if you would like.

All participants 16 years old and older will require a fishing license.

Emergency Procedures

All Scouts are asked to wear their Day Camp shirt during the program.

In the event of an emergency, please notify a volunteer or reach out directly to Richard Maisel.

A Medic will be located at the Viking Lodge.
