Conclave Theme

Scouts will have the opportunity to grind wheat and build airplanes, both of which hold historical significance.

Pricing & Registration

This year, all registrations must be performed though the National Order of the Arrow Event Registration system, <u>NOAERS</u>. Lodges may create a separate registration for collecting travel fees, however each individual must register through NOAERS as there is no contingent option active.

All attendees must be in good standing with the local Lodge and Council, including but not limited to, having a YPT completion date on or after 09/16/2022 and being current on both Scouting America dues, registration, and lodge dues (if applicable).

Pricing

Member - \$60 New Ordeal Member - \$50 (Ordeal completion from October 2023 to September 2024) Starting September 1st, 2024, a late registration fee of \$15 will be added to each individual.

Location and Parking

Dane G. Hansen Scout Reservation, home of Camp Hansen, is located at 1004 Lake Road in Kirwin, KS which is 2 miles southwest of Kirwin and is a part of the Kirwin National Wildlife Refuge.

Lodges will be allowed to drive one vehicle into their campsite to transport gear, otherwise vehicles must be parked in the main lot, just beyond the first gate, the remainder of the weekend.

 - \$10 per scout, covers rental of equipment for the entire free climb period.
- Tech Building Open House Check out Camp Hansen's one-of-a-kind technology center, showcasing industrial trades and technological focused rooms such as Welding, Woodworking, Automotive Maintenance, and Robotics!
- Cardboard Airplanes Harness your inner engineer and Design your own cardboard airplane in the home of aviation, Kansas! Planes will be launched in competition against other lodges to see who can fly the farthest!
