

#### **Course Dates**

Part 1: September 26-28, 2025 Part 2: October 11-12, 2025

(Attendance and participation are required at both weekend sessions to complete course.)

- Part 1 begins early Friday morning and ends early Sunday evening.
- Part 2 begins early Saturday morning and ends early Sunday evening.
- Mid-month remote meeting will be established during the first weekend of the course.
- Many of the learning activities are teambuilding exercises, so leaving the camp during the weekend sessions is highly discouraged and may disqualify you from completing the course.

#### **Registration Information**

- Course Fee = \$225 (early bird discount) if paid in full by June 31, 2025.
- \$250 if paid in full by August 1, 2025.
- \$280 if paid after August 1, 2025.
- One of the lowest fees in the nation!
- Note: Non-refundable deposit of \$50.00.
- Registration by September 1 is <u>required</u>.
- Early registration is encouraged because these courses fill up quickly!

#### **Requirements to Attend**

The requirements to attend Wood Badge are easy to fulfill. You must:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Be a registered member of BSA.
- Have a completed current Health Forms Part A, B & C available at:

www.scouting.org/scoutsource/HealthandSafety/ahmr.aspx

- Be "trained" for your position:
  - New Leader Essentials + Leader Specific Training for your registered Scouting position.
  - Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters must have completed Outdoor Skills Training.
  - Or have completed a previous basic training course for your position.
- You may attend the new "Wood Badge for the 21st Century" course if you completed the old Wood Badge course prior to 2019.

#### **Wood Badge Scholarships**

Since this training will directly benefit your unit, please check with your unit's committee and express your interest in attending Wood Badge. Your unit or your chartering organization may have funds available to assist you with the cost of the course.

Your employer may determine that it is important to support your efforts to attend Wood Badge because of the many skills you will learn that are applicable outside of Scouting!
