

SPRING OUTDOOR/CAMPING GEAR SWAP

Buy, Sell or Trade your gently used outdoor & camping items.

Seller Information and Conditions of Registration

DATE: Sunday, May 4th

TIME: 1 p.m. – 3 p.m.

LOCATION: Durham Scout Center, 12401 West Maple Road, Omaha, NE 68164

1. Sellers must register for their space prior to the date of the gear swap online at:

While there is no cost to set up a “Swap Site” we need to know how many groups/individuals we have participating in order to plan spaces accordingly.
2. Sellers do not need to be registered or affiliated with the BSA, the Mid-America Council or any unit of the BSA.
3. Sellers should communicate a general list of types of items they plan to bring to the gear swap to facilitate good advertising of the event and what will be offered. This can be done by emailing mac@scouting.org.
4. Please only bring items that are in reasonable repair or better.
5. This event is primarily to encourage the circulation of camping/outdoor gear within our community.
6. It is encouraged that sellers have a method by which to accept digital currency such as Venmo, CashApp, Zelle or similar, although it is not required. Sellers are responsible for the collection of funds for their own items.
7. Sellers will be responsible for tagging/pricing of their own items.
8. Booth spaces are approximately 10' x 15'.
9. Spaces will be assigned prior to the event and communicated to sellers in the week prior to the event. Please make a note in your reservation if you have any special requests or needs. (Like you need grass to display a tent, or access to electricity to demonstrate proper operation of an item.
10. Sellers are responsible for providing their own tables if needed.
11. Set-Up of your items may begin at noon and all remaining items must be removed by 4 p.m.
12. Sellers are expected to remain set up and available to sell for the entire duration of the event: 1 p.m. – 3 p.m. If you sell all of your gear prior to 3 p.m., you are welcome to break down your space, however you will need wait until after 3 p.m. to remove your setup as it will discourage incoming customers from shopping.
13. Parking for unloading and loading of your vehicle is allowed. Please make plans to unload your gear and move your vehicle prior to setting up your space so that other sellers have space to unload as well. Instructions will be given upon your arrival, but sellers should park their vehicles in the farthest spaces and leave the closest spaces available to shoppers.
14. Please have your entire setup taken down and ready to pack into your vehicle before retrieving your vehicle to load.
