The Tri-State High Adventure Base (T-SHAB) is the Mid-America Council's local high adventure base, and is the ULTIMATE adventure for Scouts and Venturers in Nebraska, Iowa, and South Dakota. T-SHAB will be in its 5th year of operation in 2019, offering two treks each week down the Missouri River and covering over 164 miles of shoreline in an "urban" adventure. Missouri River Trek

Canoe the Missouri River from Vermillion, South Dakota to downtown Omaha, Nebraska, landing in 3 states along the way, covering over 164 miles; visit state parks and cities, camping in a mix of urban and rural settings; complete the BSA's Kodiak Challenge, climb a 40-foot rock wall, visit historic sites, and maybe even catch a movie. What Does a Scout get out of T-SHAB?

- Earn up to three 50-miler awards
- Canoe trek experience to prepare for attending Northern Tier High Adventure Base
- 6-day adventure to highlight your Scouting career



Who can participate?

Scouts must be at least 14 years old, or 13 and completed the 8th grade, by the first day of the trek. All participants, youth and adults, must be able to pass a BSA swim test during check-in at camp. Participants must be able to demonstrate reasonably strong canoeing skills, but Scouts don't need to have completed the Canoeing merit badge. All participants must be physically fit, meeting BSA height/weight requirements outlined in Part D of the BSA Annual Health and Medical Record.

Interested to Staff T-SHAB?

T-SHAB hires River Guides who are at least 18 years old to lead crews down the Missouri River. Strengthen your canoeing, camping, and leadership experience by working all summer at our local high adventure base. Applicants can apply online at TSHAB.org.
