

Troop Expectations

Thank you for your interest in participating in Soaring Eagle District's Webelos Woods, which is scheduled for October 4-6, 2019 at Camp Wa-kon-da. Webelos Woods is a great recruiting opportunity for troops, and we hope your troop will volunteer. Please review the below list of expectations as you consider participating.

- Approximately two adults and eight scouts from your troop will host several Webelos with their parents at your assigned campsite for the weekend. Please do not plan on bringing your entire troop.
- The troop will work with the Webelos to prepare a breakfast and dinner at the campsite. Saturday lunch and Sunday breakfast will be served. A Friday night cracker barrel will also be held at each troop campsite.
- The troop will provide a program teaching various Scout skills on Saturday to all Webelos in attendance.
- Troops will be needed to do opening and closing flag ceremonies and to run a Scout's Own service on Sunday morning.
- Adult leaders will be needed to assist with two parent meetings on Saturday regarding the Webelos-to-Scout transition.
- Adult or Scout volunteers will be needed to assist with various tasks during the weekend.
- As this is a recruiting event, troops should provide contact information for an adult troop recruiting leader. That contact information will be published through the MAC calendar in connection with registration information.
- Each troop should provide one or two adult volunteers to attend approximately four planning meetings prior to Webelos Woods. Troops will assist with planning program activities and menu. The same people should plan to attend every meeting.
