Dear Participant:

Congratulations on being registered to attend the Mid-America Council's NYLT (National Youth Leadership Training Course). Please note that this year we are offering two separate week-long NYLT Courses (June and July), so dates regarding check-in/out are listed for each respective course.

NYLT is a seven-day, high-energy, outdoor, youth leadership training adventure. During the course, you and other youth leaders from all over our Council and, sometimes, other nearby councils, will be living, camping and working together as members of a patrol and troop. During the week of the NYLT, you will have a chance to try out many new leadership skills that you can use in your own unit. Because you are a leader in your unit, or soon will be, you naturally want to know how to do your job better. Providing you with a "toolbox of leadership skills" will be a major focus of NYLT.

Attached to each respective course's registration weblink (located at bottom of this letter) are several information items including information about a medical form that needs to be completed and returned as directed or brought to the pre-course orientation meeting. An optional 60 minute Pre-course Orientation is scheduled for May 18, 2019 at the Durham Scout Center (12401 W Maple Rd, Omaha, Nebraska) starting at 8:30 AM. Be sure to bring your Personal Health and Medical form and the completed Medical Form Checklist to the pre-course meeting if you have your physical done by then. This is the only meeting for participants before the course. It is highly recommended (though **not** required) that you and your parent (and/or Scout leader if you wish) attend the pre-course. At the pre-course, we will answer any questions that you may have and give you an opportunity to meet several key NYLT youth and adult leaders. If you have a conflict and cannot attend, while optional **it is in your best interest to mail (to the address at the top of this letter) your medical form and the completed medical**

form checklist so that they are received no later than two weeks prior to each course or provide the information to Mr. Lorenzen that is listed in the physical form instructions to ensure correct completion.

NYLT course check-in at Camp Cedars (room above medic station) begins at 11am on Sunday, June 2nd/July 28th, and the course concludes at 9:00 am on Saturday, June 8th/August 3rd. Participants must plan to arrive on time and stay for the entire course. No lunch will be served after check-in, so please plan accordingly.

NYLT will be busy with lots of activities. For this reason, we must discourage visitors during the week. Mail will be delivered to us daily. The camp mailing address is:
