

Opening Ceremonies

The presentation of colors, along with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by recital of the Scout Oath, the Scout Law, and the Outdoor Code.

Closing Ceremonies

Have the camp form a circle. Each Scout places his/her left arm around the shoulder of the Scout on their left and their right arm around the shoulder of the Scout on their right.

Camp Director: Now may the Great Master of all Scouts be with us until we meet again.

Shooting Sports

A certified BSA Rangemaster will be onsite in the assigned area conducting a BB Gun session for each period throughout the day. Please remember the Rangemaster has ultimate and final decision on everything in this area and will remove a Scout(s) from the range for safety.

Nature Education Hike

This is a leader led activity. Pair up the Scouts with the Buddy System. Lead the Scouts on a mile and a half hike to the west around the loop in the peninsula and then back east along the lake to the start of the breakwater and back. See the map below for hiking directions. Educational displays are present in specific areas during the hike, but are not noted here. Expect the hike time to take an entire 45 minute period.



Special Guest Presentation

A special guest presentation will be provided at the end of the day. The Yutan Volunteer Fire Department Water Rescue Squad is currently scheduled to provide a water rescue demonstration.

VR Demonstration

In sticking with the theme of "Under the Sea", a virtual reality demonstration will be used to showcase a game called Ocean Descent under the east pavilion (marked on the map).

Dive into an ocean adventure as a deep sea explorer. Plunge into the depths within the – comparative – safety of a suspended shark cage and marvel at the incredible marine life all around you as you descend.

This showcase is roughly 5 - 10 minutes. If time allows leadership will let Scouts to try it several times. This VR demo runs on a PlayStation 4 with a PSVR head unit.

Yard Games

An assortment of Yard Games will be available for the Cub Scouts to play and participate in.

<u>Fishing</u>

Fishing will take place during the Wahoo Day Camp. Scouts under the age of 16 do not need a fishing license, however accompanying adults who plan to fish do. The Cub Scout Leaders will not be responsible for securing or checking licenses.

Fishing rods and other needed equipment will be provided from the BSA Day Camp Trailer. We will be operating a catch and release program.

Dismissal Area

The Dismissal Area is a central playground to be used at the end of the day while Scouts wait for their parents after check-out and clean-up.

S.T.E.M. Projects

Seabed Excavation Kit

<u>Supplies</u>

- Seabed Block
- Excavation Tools

Directions

Provide one pre-made seabed block to the Scouts along with their choice of excavation tools. The Scout can "excavate" their seabed treasures to find seashells along with other seabed items.

Color Layer Experiment

Supplies

- Empty Peanut Butter Jar
- Water
- Sugar
- Dye

Directions

Using 4 small cups, fill equally with water. Put one spoonful of sugar in the first cup, two spoonfuls in the second cup, three in the third cup, and four in the fourth cup. Stir sugar to dissolve in the water, and then dye.

Fill the jar with the cup with the most sugar, then proceed to the least in order. As the sugar water is placed in layers, the density of the layers will remain intact.

This is a good experiment to teach the Scouts about water density and how different ingredients added to water can change the density of it.

S.T.E.M. Projects

Float or Sink Experiment

Supplies

- Random Household Items (located in bucket)
- Large Bucket of Water

Directions

This is a leader led presentation. Have the Scouts surround the table and guess if the items displayed will float or sink, then test them out.

Explain buoyancy/upthrust, is an upward force exerted by a fluid that opposes the weight of the immersed object.

Sea Monkey Display

<u>Supplies</u>

Sea Monkey Kit

Directions

This is more of a display than an experiment. Have the Scouts count the animals or just simply watch all of the fun and interesting things that they do. Use it as a break between other S.T.E.M. activities if necessary but please be sure to monitor the display.

Sea Slime

<u>Supplies</u>

- Glue
- Borax
- Glitter

<u>Directions</u>

Pour the glue into a bowl. Gradually add the slime activator, mixing with your hand. Mix in the glitter.

Play with it right away or put it in a bag for later or to take home.
