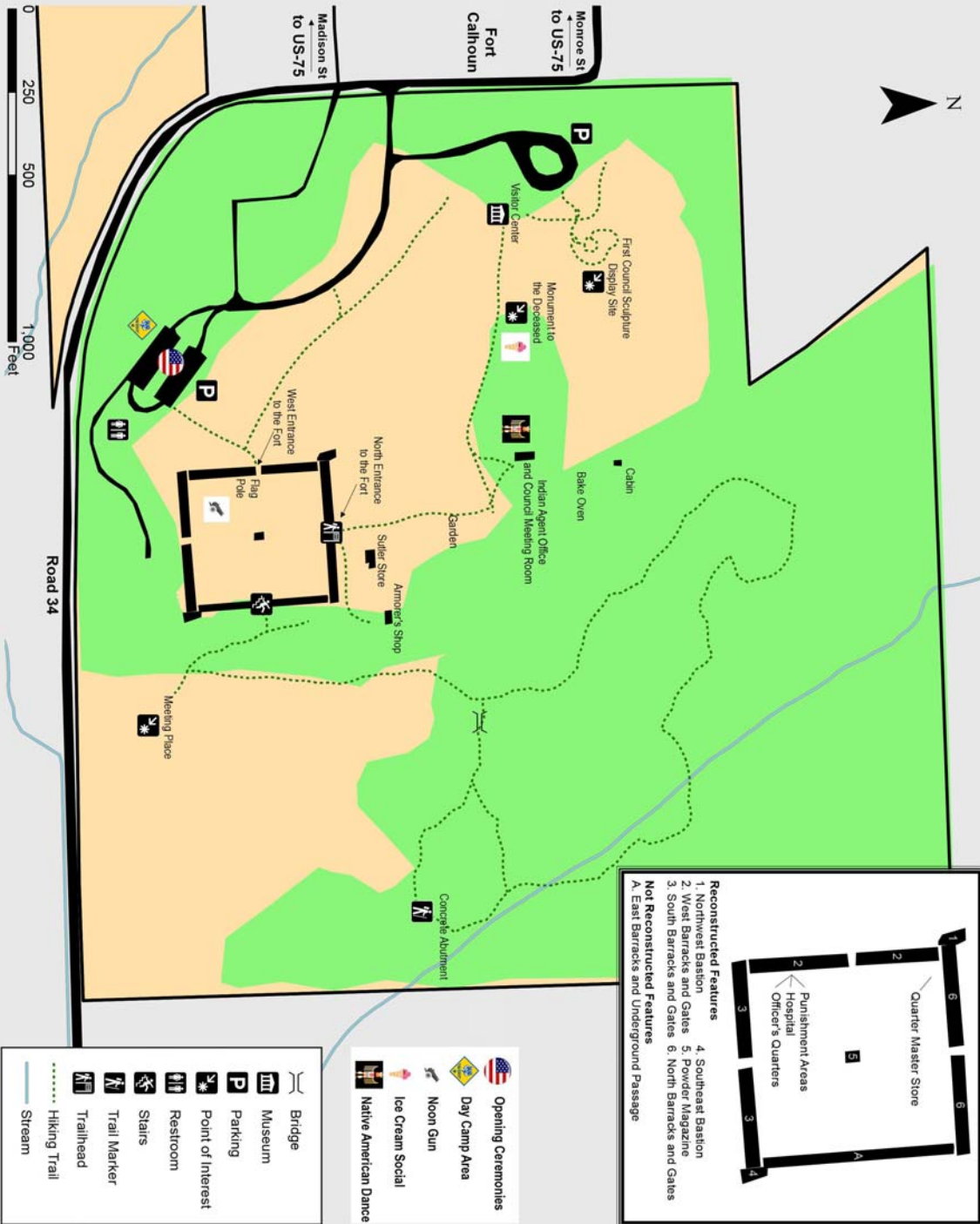

Seabed Excavation Kit

Scouts will be provided one pre-made seabed block along with their choice of excavation tools. The Scout can “excavate” their seabed treasures to find sea animals along with other seabed items.

Homemade Water Filter

By using natural materials that mimic the water cycle of the Earth, Scouts will learn how the process of infiltration works and create a water filter that works.

Sea Slime

Scouts will learn to make sea slime with basic household materials. If time allows, Scouts can add their excavated treasures to the slime to make it more exciting!

Fort Atkinson Activities

Scouts will have a chance to explore an early American fort during scheduled periods.

Activities include:

- 12:00 PM - noon gun inside the fort walls
- 12:30 PM - ice cream social in the locust grove
- 01:00 PM - Native American dancing near the council house
