



Tri-County Fire Corps Cadet Program

Code of Conduct/Expectations

Attendance at all Tri-County Fire Corps functions is mandatory.

Tri-County Cadet shall be neat and clean in appearance. While participating in the Tri-County Fire Corps Cadet Program, the Cadet is, in effect, representing the Tri-County Fire Corps Program.

Tri-County Cadet shall wear the uniform shirt provided, long pants and closed toe shoes. Cadet is required to wear the official ID Badge issued by Tri-County Fire Corps at all times while participating in official Cadet activities. The uniform shirt and ID may not be worn outside official functions without prior permission.

Hair: Long hair must be pulled back and tied so as to not interfere with activities.

Cadet must know, understand and follow all rules of conduct at participating Fire Departments performing Fire Corps activities.

No firearms or other weapons may be brought onto fire department property or carried during the program.

At no time will Cadets be permitted to take pictures, use a video camera or any other audio-visual recording device while participating in Tri-County Fire Corps. Cellphone usage shall be reserved for emergency use only and will not be permitted to be used while conducting training.

Tri-County Fire Corps reserves the right to remove, suspend or repeal a cadet from the program for cause.
