CHECK IN

Check-in will begin at 8:00am on Saturday morning and continue until 9am.

DISMISSAL

ALL Merit Badge classes will end at 3pm. **All Scouts must be picked up no later than 3:30pm.**

MERIT BADGE BLUE CARDS

As per the Guide to Advancement, each Scout must meet with their unit leader about which merit badges they'd like to start.

Once approved, your leader will issue a signed blue card. Bring the signed blue card to the merit badge fair and turn it in to the merit badge counselor at your session. **Blue cards will not be issued at the event—please make sure they are signed in advance.**

Completion of requirements and approval of merit badges are at the discretion of the merit badge counselor, in accordance with Scouting America guidelines.

****Important:** Simply attending a session does not guarantee completion. Scouts are expected to complete any prerequisites, actively participate in discussions and activities, and fulfill all requirements as determined by the counselor.

MERIT BADGE CLASSES

Questions about a particular merit badge should be directed to Merit Badge Counselors. Counselors may reach out to Scouts once they have signed up for their class.

DRESS CODE

Scouts are expected to come in Class A uniform.

CELL PHONE POLICY

Phones and other electronic devices are to be on mute and put away during merit badge sessions. Depending on the nature of a particular merit badge, a Merit Badge Counselor may allow use of cell phones to aid in completing merit badge requirements.

FOOD

Lunch is scheduled for 12:00 - 12:45pm. Food is not included in the cost of the Fair. The Order of the Arrow will have hot dogs and other lunch items for sale. Scouts can also bring their own bag lunches. Classes will resume at 1pm. All Scouts need to bring their own water.

PREREQUISITES & MATERIALS

Merit badges recognize a Scout's proficiency in a life skill, trade, or hobby. To honor that purpose, Scouts must complete all listed prerequisites before arriving at the Merit Badge Fair. Scouts who do not complete the prerequisites may receive a partial or may not be permitted to attend the class.

All requirements are approved at the discretion of the Merit Badge Counselor in accordance with BSA guidelines. Please note that some merit badges cannot be completed during the fair and will require additional work afterward. Scouts may continue working with the Merit Badge Fair Counselor or choose to finish the badge with another approved counselor. Before leaving the fair, Scouts must obtain the counselor's signature for any partially completed requirements.

Scouts are expected to review the merit badge pamphlet and requirements in advance and come prepared for discussion.

Please bring your merit badge workbook, notebook, completed prerequisites, and a pen or pencil to each class.
