Marksmanship Experience — \$875 (per shooter)

No experience necessary to be successful. Griffin & Howe instructors will guide you through a 2-hour long-range target shoot off, using a combination of our realistic animal targets and steel plates. Target distances can vary from 100 to 900 yards, shooting from different positions such as kneeling or lying down. All equipment and training is provided. Maximum of 8 shooters will be accommodated. Runs simultaneously with sporting clays. Includes buffet lunch, cocktails, and dinner.

Advanced Shotgun Experience — \$700 (Per Shooter)

Griffin & Howe offers a highly engaging series of trap, five stand and flurries. 2 rounds of each game provide high-energy fun and extreme competition! Each guest gets 175 rounds of total and a chance to win the ultimate bragging rights. Ideal for those with shotgun experience. Introductory Fly-Fishing Experience — \$675 (Per Angler)
