Option 1

Whole Day (8:30 a.m. - Dinner) - \$6,000

Includes fly fishing or archery in the morning;
Sporting clays in the afternoon;

No prior experience necessary to participate in fly fishing or archery.

Option 2

Whole Day (8:30 a.m. - Dinner) - \$6,200

Includes skeet/Annie Oakley/5-Stand in the morning;
Sporting clays in the afternoon;

Must be an experienced shotgun shooter to participate.

Option 3

Half Day (Noon - Dinner) - \$4,000

- 100 rounds of sporting clays.
- All shooters will receive an ammo bag to take home.
- Golf attire, no jeans allowed.
- Only break open double barrel guns allowed on course (rentals available). No semi-auto shotguns permitted.
- No cell phone use allowed on course.
- Minimum age of 10 years old to participate with release signed by an adult.
- Hudson Farm Club will allocate an instructor and Polaris Ranger to every team.
- This is a rain or shine event.
- Maximum 80 shooters allowed for sporting clays.
