Sells out at 12 participants

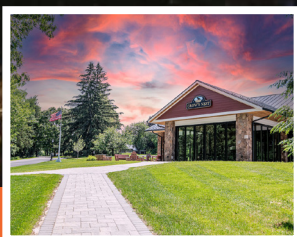

All shoots are 100 rounds of sporting clays (except for clinic).

Golf attire strictly enforced, no jeans allowed.

Only break open double barrel shotguns allowed on course.

No cell phone use allowed on course.

Minimum age of 10 years old to participate with release signed by an adult.

Hudson Farm Club will provide an instructor and Polaris Ranger to every team.

This is a rain or shine event.

Maximum 80 shooters allowed for sporting clays.

12:00 noon: Arrival for **Premium Packages 3 & 4 and Shooting Clays teams** for registration and buffet lunch

1:30 p.m.: Sporting Clays Start

5:00 p.m.: Cocktails & Dinner
