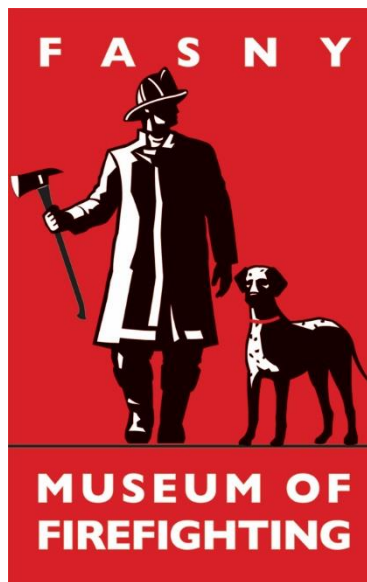

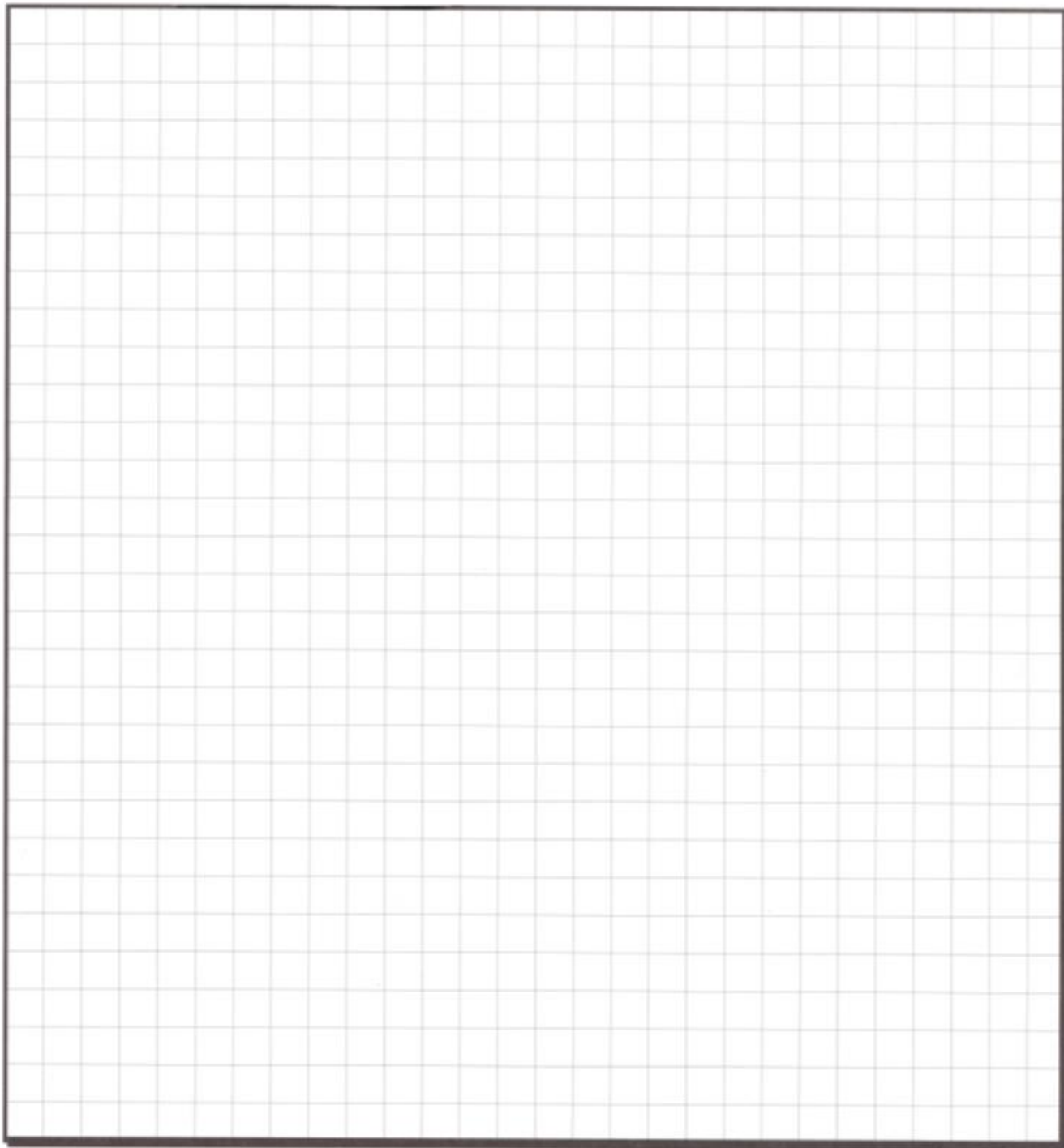

Conduct a home safety survey with the help of an adult. Then do the following:


