Prerequisite Courses: Youth Protection Training. To receive BALOO training certificate, you must attend this outdoor course AND complete the online BALOO Prerequisite Training course prior to the overnight course. (Courses may be taken online at <https://my.scouting.org>) Please bring your printed certificates of completion to this course. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught, along with the discovery of the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience. **Completion of this course is mandatory for a MINIMUM OF ONE adult attending a Pack overnigher.**

You should also feel comfortable wearing a mask for health reasons if you so choose.
