Skill instruction for teaching Tenderfoot through First Class ranks. Please plan to arrive and check in at the Seneca Lodge by 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning. Use the Scouts BSA handbook and the list below for items you need to bring. You will be camping outdoors in tents.

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills: Gather new skills based on outdoor training found in the Scouts BSA handbook. The purpose is to build confidence and competence for outdoor camping and activities. This training is required for all Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, and Venture Crew Coaches in order to be considered position “Trained.” To be fully trained as a Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmaster, or Venture Crew Coach, position-specific training, IOLS and Hazardous Weather Training must be completed.

What to bring: Tent, Sleeping bag, Sleeping pad, Scout BSA handbook, Mess kit, Water bottle filled, Personal clothes, Toiletries, Flashlight, Compass, Notebook and pen, Class “A” & “B” uniform shirts, Lantern.
