The Spring Camporee is coming up soon - is your patrol hungry, yet? I'm sure you are - "A Scout is Hungry" is the unofficial 13th point of the Scout Law, after all...

The *Hungry Games* Camporee will have lots of fun activities for your patrol to take part in all day on Saturday.

In the morning, we'll have cooking competitions for breakfast, where each patrol will cook something from the same ingredients. Then you'll want to practice your knots, because the first thing after breakfast, every Scout will be tying some knots to earn foods for the patrol at The Roping. After that, there will be a rotation around ten or so stations, competing with other patrols for points. Then your patrol will cook with whatever ingredients they've managed to snag in the Roping to make something entirely new for lunch.



In the afternoon you'll be able to visit any of a dozen or more stations with demonstrations or activities on a food theme, many of which will involve trying something new to eat. You'll pick up lots of ideas to improve the food on your patrol's next campout! We're still recruiting experts to run stations, but here are a few examples of those we have signed up already:

Warriors use Swords and Boards; EZ-Cleanup Cooking for Backpacking; Dehydrated Foods; Spices and Hot Stuff; Mexican Food; Eat your Science; Not Your Mom's Ramen; So You Think You Don't Like Broccoli?; Dutch Oven Cooking; Understanding Dietary Issues

The day will end with a Traveling Feast, where each patrol will present a dish for everyone to try. Your patrol members will switch off serving and wandering around trying everyone else's cooking. Vote for your favorite meals by dropping tokens in a cup - the winning meals will earn points and a special prize (and then you can eat the tokens). Finally, we'll have a campfire with songs and skits on a food theme.

Sunday morning we'll have a Scouts' Own service (A Scout is Reverent) before we go home.
