

Packing List for Cub Resident Camps

Pack everything into an easy-to-carry pack, duffel bag or suitcase. Bring ample clothing for the length of time of your encampment. Remember to plan for the possibility of rain.

ESSENTIAL ITEMS

- All Paperwork for each participant including a Signed BSA Annual Health & Medical Record
- Necessary Medications-In original container
- Jacket, Rain Coat, or Poncho
- Water bottle
- Sweatshirt
- Cub Scout Uniform
- Blanket/Sleeping Bag and Pillow
- Bath Towel, Washcloth
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Soap/Shampoo
- Comb/Brush
- Socks
- Underwear
- Bag for Dirty Clothes
- Shorts
- Short Sleeve Shirts
- Long Pants
- Swimsuit and Beach Towel
- Insect Repellent
- Sun Screen
- Flashlight with Fresh Batteries
- Comfortable closed toed shoes
- Money for Trading Post



OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Fishing Pole and supplies
 - Water Shoes
 - Lawn chair
 - Camp lantern
 - Book of skits and songs
 - Camera
 - Knapsack or backpack for extra gear
 - Pocket knife (per leader discretion)
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- Be sure you have your name on all of your equipment and clothing.
 - Leaders may want to act as "banks" for their Cubs' money, giving it out as the Scout needs or wants it.
