Founders Awards Presented at Council Dinner

Introduced at the 1981
National Order of the
Arrow Conference, the
Founder's Award
recognizes Arrowmen
who have given
outstanding service to
their lodge. This award
is reserved for an
Arrowman who
demonstrates that he or
she personifies the
spirit of selfless service,
as advocated by founder

E. Urner Goodman and cofounder Carroll A. Edson.

The award is a handsome bronze medallion bearing the likenesses of E. Urner Goodman and Carroll A. Edson, with a wooden base and a brass plate suitable for engraving. Available for uniform wear is a gold-colored arrow

suspended from a red ribbon.

Lodges may petition the national Order of the Arrow committee to present between two and four awards annually, depending on the number of members in the lodge. If the lodge presents more than one award, at least one must be awarded to a youth under the age of 21.

The Tkäen DōD Lodge selected James Thomas in 2023 and Don Many in 2024 and both were recently presented at the Council Annual Dinner.









Silver Beaver's Presented at Council Dinner

The Silver Beaver Award is presented upon action of a Council Executive Board. This award is for outstanding service to youth within the Council or for outstanding longtime service to youth by a registered Scouter residing within that Council. The average tenure for Silver Beaver candidates is ten years or longer. Career members of the Boy Scouts of America may receive this award upon concurrence of the Council Scout Executive and the Director

of Operations at the National office, BSA.

Candidates for this award must be nominated. At the Council Annual Dinner many Lodge Members were recognized for their service, but three out of four are faces regularly seen around an OA Campfire. Congratulations again to Tom Miller, Ryan Ross, Joe Taylor, and Eileen Fisher.
