



How to *Sign Up* for Summer Camp

Registering for summer camp shouldn't be its own adventure. Follow these steps so you can save the real adventure for camp!

Fall: Choose a camp

1. Get camp information from the website or your Scout Service Center
2. Identify a Camping Coordinator to lead the process
3. Talk with Scouts & parents
4. Determine which camp(s) and dates will work
5. Pay site deposit to secure your preferred week

Winter: Organize & plan

1. Create a camp roster of Scouts, parents, leaders
2. Review costs and deposit deadlines, plan fundraisers
3. Pay bunk deposits



Spring: Finish registration

1. Register Scouts on the website
2. Collect fees from families and complete payment
3. Each attendee completes BSA Health and Medical Records (parts A,B,C - includes form for doctor to sign)
4. Ensure all adults attending camp are registered and complete YPT as required

Remember:

- Camperships are available to help families attend - apply by March 15.
- Camp registration early bird pricing ends May 15.
- You can go to camp as an individual - find out how at gfcscouting.org/camping
