This is an opportunity to become NRA Basic Firearms Trained in one day. This course will be offered as part of the 2020 University of Scouting program, but will take place **OFF CAMPUS** at the Painted Post Field & Stream Club on Beartown Road & will include the required shooting components to complete the training program.
