



2021 Covid considerations

Both camps are following CDC guidelines

1. Masks will be worn at all times outside of the campsite.
2. All essential visitors must be vaccinated and submit a Vaccination and Testing Verification form upon arrival.
3. All Campers (youth and adult) must meet one of three criteria before attending camp:
 - a. Be vaccinated.
 - b. Have had Covid within 3 months of attending camp.
 - c. Family has secured a negative Covid-19 test, 72 hours prior to attending.
4. A Vaccination and Testing Verification Form will need to be completed by all campers that certifies their completion of one of the three above standards. This will need to be attached to the med-form at check-in.
5. A unit attending camp (or a group of units sharing a site) will be considered a stable group.
6. Vaccinated and Unvaccinated campers do not need to wear a mask when they are in their stable group (campsite) after the third day of camp assuming they had no sick campers in the first several days.
7. There will be little or no mixing of troops / Packs.
8. Camp wide activities will be at a minimum.
9. There will be no outposts or out of camp trips this year.
10. No casual visitors will be allowed.
11. Once you leave camp you cannot return.
12. Camp Wide activities will be at a minimum.
13. Each site will have their own space in each program area and must stay in their space.
14. We will not be supplying tents this summer. You should bring your own tents, rain flies and ground cover.
 - a. Tents can only be shared by family members within 2 years of age. Everyone else must have their own tent.
15. All meals will be served in the pavilion or in a tent next to the dining hall. Only staff will eat in the dining hall.

16. The check in process will be scheduled for each troop for a specific time. Missing your scheduled time will send you to the end of the line.
 - a. Your troop must all check in at the same time.
17. There will be no walk ins or visitors allowed. EVERYONE must be pre-registered and pre-paid.
18. There will be a number of forms required this year. Missing medical paperwork will be an automatic go home. **NOBODY can enter camp without the proper signed paperwork.**
 - a. BSA health form parts A, B and C. Signed by parent and physician.
 - b. AHC Covid acknowledgement form
 - c. Co Vaccination and Testing Verification
 - d. Medication Permission Form for under 18 signed by parent and physician.
19. Camp theme T-shirts are only available online and will not be sold at camp.
20. All fees including MB fees and special meals must be paid prior to arrival.
