

Destination Wood Badge Packing List



Wear the official BSA uniform for your current Scouting position. (Note: A complete uniform includes the official BSA shirt with colored epaulets [shoulder loops] signifying your branch of Scouting; official BSA shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes; official BSA socks; and official BSA belt (web or leather). Neckerchief and slide will be provided.

There will be occasions to wear a Scout activity uniform (Class B) which consists of a Scout T-shirt or Scout knit shirt; official BSA Scout shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes; official BSA socks; and official BSA belt (web or leather).

During the week there is the likelihood of warm days and cool nights in late August. The first column is Required, the second is Encouraged, the third is Optional and the fourth is a Do-Not-Bring column followed by Outdoor Experience items.
